whereas, the health of Puget Sound is declining, and creatures and plants great and small, from our bull kelp forests, and salmon, to our orcas, shellfish and creatures, are at risk from the human impacts of stormwater runoff, loss of natural habitats, and a changing climate; and

WHEREAS, we all have the power to protect our Puget Sound treasure, work together to discover and take clean water actions through the Puget Sound Starts Here Campaign; and

whereas, in the month of September the City of Edmonds will join with other governing bodies, organizations and community groups to strengthen stewardship of our shared watershed and encourage all to take action to improve the health of Puget Sound;
