## **DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

**Description of proposal:** This is a non-project action to adopt amendments to the building code and related codes in Title 19 of the Edmonds Community Development Code (ECDC). These code updates would replace codes adopted by City Council in Ordinance 4212.
